
Utah's Retirement-Age Population: Geography, Age, and Growth







Share of Residents Age 65 and Older by County, 2022 5-Year Estimates






Births in U.S. and Utah, 1940-2022

Over 60% of Retirement Age Utahns and Salt Lake County residents are younger than 75





Age Groups by Race and Ethnicity in Utah, 2022







Utah Labor Force Participation Rate by Age and Sex, 2017-2021






Utah Poverty Rate by Sex and Age, 2017-2021

99% of Utahns over 65 have health insurance coverage.


Utah Health Insurance Coverage by Age, 2017-2021




Utah Tenure by Age of Householder



Utah Homeowners by Age, 2018-2022












Tenure by Age, SL Co. 2023






How Long Have Seniors Lived in Their Current Home? Share by Tenure SL Co 2023



What Type of Homes do Seniors Live in? SL Co, 2023




Share of Real Estate Owned by Generation and Median Age, U.S. 2023



Median Sales Price & Monthly Mortgage Payment







Income Needed to Afford the Median Priced Home 2024 Jan-June



Cost of Renting vs. Owning - Wasatch Front



Eroding Affordability- Renter are Stuck Renting


Share of Renter Households that Can't Afford a Median Priced Home, Utah







Cost Burden Share of All 65+ HH






65+ Cost Burden w/Mortgage




Household Composition, by Age, US
